Encounter natural ice sculptures, hear the calls of penguins multiplied by the thousands, watch Leopard Seals and sea lions perfectly at ease relaxing on floating ice, experience the magnificence of a whale breaching from beneath cold ocean waters. Afterwards return to the elegant surrounds and cosmopolitan atmosphere of the *Prince Albert II*.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Board your private charter flight from Buenos Aires to Ushuaia* to embark the *Prince Albert II*. Sail through Beagle Channel. **Days 2/3:** Cross the Drake Passage. **Days 4-9:** Explore the dramatic beauty of the Antarctic Peninsula, including spectacular icebergs, calving glaciers, and close up encounters with a variety of penguins, seals and whales. Attempt at least two Zodiac excursions per day (weather permitting) to view penguin rookeries and research stations. **Days 10/11:** Re-cross Drake Passage towards Ushuaia. **Day 12:** Following breakfast, disembark in Ushuaia for your return private charter flight to Buenos Aires*. Tour ends.

*Note: We advise that clients spend a pre and post tour night in Buenos Aires as the flight to Ushuaia leaves at 0830 with a 2 hour check in requirement, and the return charter flight arrives in Buenos Aires late in the afternoon.

18 days/17 nights Departs ex Buenos Aires, Argentina

Follow in the footsteps of explorers with names like Roald Amundsen, James Weddell, James Clark Ross and Ernest Shackleton to the last great frontier – Antarctica's vast white wilderness. From the deluxe Prince Albert II you will visit the remote and wildlife rich Sub-Antarctic Islands including the Falklands, South Georgia, South Orkney and Elephant Island before continuing on to explore the Antarctic Peninsula. Witness unforgettable landscapes and encounter unique wildlife.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Board your private charter flight from Buenos Aires to Ushuaia* to embark the Prince Albert II for departure. **Days 2-4:** Sail to the Falkland Islands. View colonies of Black-Browed Albatross, Rockhopper, Magellanic and Gentoo Penguins and visit Stanley. **Days 5-10:** Continue farther south with possible whale sightings to South Georgia Island featuring abundant birdlife, the largest King Penguin colony in the world and the location of Ernest Shackleton's grave. **Days 11/12:** Sail into Antarctic waters via the South Orkney Islands and Elephant Island – so named for its abundance of Elephant Seals. **Days 13-15:** Cruise the spectacular waters of the Antarctic Peninsula. Enjoy shore landings by Zodiac (weather permitting), wildlife encounters, and enjoy the stunning scenery of giant icebergs and glaciers. **Days 16/17:** Re-cross Drake Passage towards Ushuaia. **Day 18:** Following breakfast, disembark in Ushuaia for your return private charter flight to Buenos Aires*. Tour ends.
