HIGH ARCTIC

11 days, 13 days or 14 days

Departs ex Kangerlussuaq or Resolute as specified

Cruise the starkly beautiful landscapes of the Arctic, where the icy seas and desolate tundra are home to a surprisingly diverse population of plant and animal life. You'll find thriving species such as Arctic Hare, Ptarmigan and Muskox happily feeding on the abundant berries, heather and moss. This frozen land is also the ancestral home of around 200,000 Inuit, whose rich cultures and traditions are still found in settlements scattered across the north. Summer is the only time to visit as the long daylight hours allow plenty of time for exploring.

JOURNEY TO THE SPIRIT MOUNTAINS

This 13 night voyage starts in Greenland and crosses the Arctic Circle south to Kangaamiut, cruising amongst the icebergs. Visit Nuuk and see the famous mummies, then cross Davis Strait to Canada, looking out for whales and walrus. Explore northern Labrador, the Torngat Mountains and visit the historic Viking settlement L'Anse aux Meadows.

ARCTIC SAFARI

Join this 11 day quest to meet the Arctic's Big 5 – walrus, seal, muskoxen, whales, and polar bear. The expedition combines culture, historic sites, wildlife, glaciers, fjords and spectacular scenery such as Ilulissat Icefjord and the Buchan Gulf. With blooming tundra flowers and usually calm, warm weather, this is an ideal first trip to the Arctic.

BAFFIN AND GREENLAND ADVENTURE

Enter the land of the Inuit on this 13 day adventure. Departing from Kangerlussuaq in Greenland the itinerary combines spectacular scenery and wildlife with visits to Greenlandic communities and the best of Inuit art and culture in Nunavut. Search for polar bears, walrus and whales and visit huge colonies of birds.

EPIC HIGH ARCTIC

Voyage beyond the Arctic Circle and into the far North, exploring Western Greenland, Devon Island and the historic route to the North Pole. This 11 day adventure takes in some of the most breathtaking scenery in the Arctic as well as the chance to see polar bears, muskoxen, whales and millions of seabirds. This is also the best time of year to see the eerie green glow of the Aurora Borealis.

CANADA'S NORTHWEST PASSAGE

15 days/14 nights

Departs 12 Aug 2012 ex Kangerlussuaq & 26 Aug 2012 ex Kugluktuk (reverse)

Embark on a remarkable journey through the Arctic islands and waterways of the famous Northwest Passage. Highlights include crossing the Arctic Circle, the tabular icebergs of Disko Bay, the fjords and cliffs of Baffin Island, the wildlife “super highway” of Lancaster Sound and the bird colonies of Prince Leopold Island. Explore by zodiac, kayak and on foot, discover the history of the early expeditions, visit remote fishing villages and experience fascinating local cultures.

SAMPLE ITINERARY (EX KANGERLUSSUAQ)

Day 1: After a charter flight from Edmonton or Ottawa (additional cost) to Sondre Stromfjord (Kangerlussuaq) in Greenland, embark your ship and cross the Arctic Circle via Davis Strait.

Day 2: Explore the fjord and town of Sisimiut and meet some traditional Greenlandic kayakers.

Day 3: Visit Jacobshavn Icefjord and Disko Bay with its tabular icebergs. **Days 4-7:** Follow the ice edge across Baffin Bay to Baffin Island, before visiting Pond Inlet for an Inuit cultural experience.

Days 8-10: Cruise the nutrient rich waters of Lancaster Sound before reaching Beechey Island and the bird colonies of Prince Regent Inlet. If ice conditions permit, sail through Prince Regent Inlet and Bellot Strait. **Days 11/12:** Stop at Pasely Bay and hike in the hills overlooking Larson Sound. Discover the history of Arctic exploration at Victory Point, King William Island. **Day 13/4:** Visit the community of Cambridge Bay and enjoy hiking and water based activities at Johanssen Bay. **Day 15:** Arrive in Kugluktuk (Coppermine). Charter flight to Edmonton or Ottawa (additional cost). Tour ends.
