JOURNEY TO THE SPIRIT MOUNTAINS

12 days/11 nights

Departs 02 Jul 2010 ex St John's, Newfoundland

Discover the spectacular, rugged beauty of one of Canada's least-visited regions, the coast of northern Labrador. Visit important historical and archaeological sites, and take the time for a leisurely exploration of the uncharted fiords and narrow channels formed where the Torngat Mountain Range falls into the deep North Atlantic waters. As you cruise deeper into the southward-drifting masses of breathtaking sea ice and icebergs, keep an eye out for diverse wildlife including polar bears, seals, several species of whales and huge colonies of birds.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Embark in St John's following a buffet lunch. Watch for humpback whales, puffins, storm petrels and gannets. LD **Days 2-11:** Explore the highlights of Newfoundland and Labrador's coastlines. Among the locations visited are: the UNESCO world heritage site L'Anse aux Meadows; Red Bay; picturesque Battle Harbour; the wildlife rich and remote islands around Man of War Point; cultural Makkovik; Nain; Hebron; beautiful Torngat Mountains National Park Reserve and Killiniq, location of diverse marine mammals including polar bears, seals and whales. BLD **Day 12:** Disembark Kuujuuaq. After a brief tour of the town and buffet lunch, transfer to the airport for onward flight. Tour ends. BL

The Arctic is alive with exotic wildlife, and this expedition is the best way to see it. Join us in the quest to meet the Arctic's Big 5 – walrus, caribou, muskoxen, whales, and the great white polar bear. This expedition includes visits to sites virtually untouched for thousands of years and communities steeped in history and culture such as Cape Dorset, the Inuit art capital of the world. Whether it is Inuit culture, majestic icebergs, or the incredible variety of wildlife, the “Arctic Safari” itinerary has it all. There is simply no better way to experience the Arctic for the first time.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Embark in Kuujuaq following a buffet lunch and town tour. LD **Days 2-10:** Sail along the coast of Nunavut and across the Hudson Strait towards Baffin Island. Highlights include Akpatok Island featuring soaring cliffs and wildlife including walrus and polar bears; Quaqtaq & Diana Island with its herds of roaming muskox; cultural Kangiqsujuaq; Digges Island & Mansel Island, a favourite place for polar bear; the Inuit art capital of the world Cape Dorset & historical Mallikjuak Territorial Park; Kimmirut & Katannilik Territorial Park; Nannuk Harbour with its rust-coloured cliffs, polar bears and icebergs, and Lower Savage Islands. BLD **Day 11:** Disembark just outside Nunavut's capital of Iqaluit. Tour ends. BL

ITINERARY

Day 1: Set sail from Iqaluit. LD **Days 2-13 or 14:** Cruise Baffin Island's east coast and the west coast of Greenland. Locations visited include: the Inuit community of Pangnirtung; Kerkerten Territorial Historic Park & Auyuittuq National Park; wildlife-rich Qikiqtarjuaq; Isabella Bay, Canada's first National Marine Wildlife Area; historical Uummannaq; Jakobshaven glacier; the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Ilulissat Icefiord; colourful Sisimiut; Monumental Island; Lower Savage Islands and Akpatok Island featuring soaring cliffs and wildlife including walrus and polar bears. BLD **Day 14 or 15:** Disembark Kuujuaq. After a brief tour of the town and buffet lunch, transfer to the airport for onward flight. Tour ends. BL

HIGH ARCTIC

11 days/10 nights & 10 days/9 nights

Departs 19 Aug 2010 ex Kuujuaq & 06 Sep 2010 ex Resolute

Voyaging ever northward past the Arctic Circle and into the polar desert, we explore the length of Baffin Island to the fabled Northwest Passage. The scenery is breathtaking, with towering mountains, fjords, glaciers and massive ice caps. Discover the colourful history of whalers and explorers who for more than 200 years searched unsuccessfully for a shorter route to the riches of the Orient. Weather and wildlife encounters are less predictable than elsewhere in the north, but sightings of polar bears, walrus and bowhead whales are not unusual. This is also the best time of year to see the eerie green glow of the Aurora Borealis.

ITINERARY

Day 1: Embark in Kuujuaq following a buffet lunch and town tour. LD **Days 2-10:** Venture north towards the Polar Desert. Among the locations visited are: Qikiqtarjuaq, home to sea mammals including seals, narwhals and walruses; Baffin Island with its stunning glaciers; North Arm Fiord; historical Pond Inlet; Bylot Island, a designated Migratory Bird Sanctuary; one of the richest wildlife areas in the Arctic Lancaster Sound and Beechey Island BLD **Day 11:** Disembark Resolute. After a brief tour of the town and buffet lunch, prepare for onward flight. Tour ends. BL
