### Day 1 Halifax

Arrive Halifax. Check into hotel for 2 nights.

### Day 2 Halifax

This morning enjoy a Gray Line deluxe Historic City Tour of Halifax. Afternoon free to explore. Evening welcome reception.

### Day 3 Digby

Depart Halifax for the picturesque fishing village of Peggy's Cove, then continue to the UNESCO World Heritage Town of Lunenburg; visit either the Fisheries Museum or take a walking tour of this historic community. Travel to Digby and overnight at The Pines Resort overlooking the Bay of Fundy (04 June departure may stay at Old Orchard Inn, Wolfville). BD

### Day 4 Moncton

Drive through the lush Annapolis Valley to Grand Pre and the romantic Land of Evangeline, once Acadie, immortalised through the poetry of Henry Longfellow. Drive via Truro and Amherst to Moncton in New Brunswick. B

### Days 5/6 Charlottetown

Drive to Hopewell Rocks and walk on the ocean floor at low tide. Cross the world's longest continuous multispan bridge to Prince Edward Island for a delicious lobster supper. Check into Charlottetown hotel for 2 nights. On day 6 enjoy a morning at leisure before a guided tour of Charlottetown, Canada's Birthplace. Explore Prince Edward Island National Park, described by LM. Montgomery in the "Anne of Green Gables" series, and visit the "Green Gables" farmhouse. From Jun to Sep, if schedule permits, enjoy evening musical "Anne" at the Charlottetown Festival. BD/BL

### Days 7/8 Baddeck

Board the ferry for Nova Scotia and drive to Cape Breton Island, "the Scotland of North America". Visit the Alexander Graham Bell National Historic Site in Baddeck and overnight for 2 nights at a lakeside resort. On day 8 take a coach tour along the spectacular Cabot Trail. From Jul-Sep enjoy a bonus whale watching tour (weather permitting). Visit the spectacular Cape Breton Highlands National Park. Farewell dinner. BD/BLD

### Day 9 Halifax

Visit the Fortress of Louisbourg National Historic Site, an impressive re-construction of this 18th century historic town and fortress. Explore the streets with costumed guides before continuing along the shores of Bras d'Or to the mainland. Overnight at hotel in Halifax. Guests flying out early the next morning should request the Hilton Garden Inn near the airport at the time of booking. Airport shuttle bus included. B

Check-out from hotel. Tour ends.
