

## ANCHORAGE

**S**cenic Anchorage nestles between the Chugach Mountains and Cook Inlet in Southeast Alaska. It was first settled in 1915 at the mouth of Ship Creek to support the building of the railway. Today it is the business and cultural centre of Alaska, offering a range of attractions, restaurants and shopping. Well worth a visit is the Museum of History and Art and the Alaska Native Heritage Centre.
