Drive from Cairo across the desert to Baharia Oasis, known for the Valley of the Golden Mummies and many dinosaur remains. Continue to the beautiful Farafra Oasis located near the spectacular wind and sand sculpted rocks of the White Desert.

Day 1 Baharia Oasis

Drive through the Western Desert to Baharia Oasis with picnic lunch enroute. Walk in the Black Mountains with panoramic views. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. LD

Day 2 Baharia Oasis

Today you will visit the Antiquities Museum with the golden mummies, the tombs of Qasr Selim from the 26th dynasty and the Chapels of Mufftilah. After a picnic lunch visit the temple of Alexander the Great and explore the Valley of the Gold Mummies. Dinner and overnight at your hotel. BLD

Day 3 Farafra Oasis

Set off to the White Desert with picnic lunch via the Black Desert and Crystal Mountain. Drive to Farafra Oasis. Overnight at your hotel. BLD

Day 4 Tour ends Cairo

Visit the local art museum and some natural hot springs before driving back to Cairo. Tour ends. BL

SIWA OASIS

Price per person includes: Return transfers by road from Cairo to Alexandria for 1 night on B&B basis at Renaissance Hotel or similar, 2 nights at Adrere Amellal on a full board basis, activities as per the itinerary, services of an escort and driver.

Cross the desert sands to the ancient oasis town of Siwa, one of Egypt's most spectacular sites. Dominated by the ruins of a huge 13th century fortress and shaded by date palms, time seems to have stood still here. Your route will take you via Alexandria, as well as the Western Desert and World War II battlegrounds at El Alamein.

Day 1 Alexandria

Depart Cairo by road for the historic city of Alexandria. Visit Pompey's Pillar, the Catacombs, the New Library and the National Museum. Overnight at your hotel in Alexandria.

Days 2/3 Siwa Oasis

A long drive to Siwa, visiting Marsa Matrouh city enroute. Overnight at the unique Adrere Amellal, a 5 star eco-lodge offering 40 vaulted rooms hewn from salt bricks with spectacular views of Siwa Lake and the Great Sand Sea. At the lodge, a mineral spring forms a swimming pool, and gourmet meals are made with fresh local ingredients. Activities include a tour of Siwa, Shali Fortress, the tombs of Jabal el Mawta, Oracle Temple, Cleopatra's Bath and the Petrified Forest. BLD

Day 4 Tour ends Cairo

Pay respects at the El Alamein War Museum and cemetery before returning to Cairo. Tour ends. B

Founded by Alexander the Great in 332 BC Alexandria was the capital of Graeco-Roman Egypt for almost 1000 years. With its legendary lighthouse and great Library the city was renowned as a centre for culture and learning. Today the ancient library is replaced by a modern wonder, the new Bibliotheca Alexandria. Modern Alexandria reflects much of its 19th century cosmopolitan heritage, and although just 220 kms from Cairo, seems more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern.

Day 1 Alexandria

Transfer from Alexandria airport to your hotel for 2 nights.

Day 2 Alexandria

Depart 09.00 on a day tour of Alexandria. Visit Pompey's Pillar, a column of red Aswan granite erected in honour of Emperor Diocletian. Explore the ancient Catacombs of Kom E-Shouqafa, visit the archaeological treasures of the National Museum and wander through the 114 acre El Montazah Gardens once owned by Egypt's royal family. A highlight of the tour is the new Alexandria Library, a huge tilted disc reminiscent of a rising sun on the edge of the Mediterranean. B

Day 3 Tour ends Alexandria

Transfer to the airport. Tour ends. B
