**Discover the mysteries of myth and religion on this fascinating tour that combines the ancient lands of Egypt and Jordan. Explore the archaeological treasures of Cairo, Luxor and Aswan and drift down the Nile on a leisurely cruise. Fly to Jordan and wander through the Roman ruins at Jerash, and visit the Jewel of Jordan – the ancient city of Petra hewn into sheer rock more than 2000 years ago.**

**Day 1 Inflight to Dubai**

Depart Sydney/Melbourne on Emirates to Dubai.

**Day 2 Cairo**

Arrive Dubai, onward flight to Cairo. Arrival transfer to Ramses Hilton or similar.

**Days 3/4 Cairo**

Two full days of sightseeing including the Egyptian Museum, the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx. Tour through the Egyptian countryside to Memphis, the ancient capital of Egypt to visit the Alabaster Sphinx, and the Colossus of Ramses II. Nearby is Sakkara, home to the famous Step Pyramid of Zoser. Lunch is included on each day of touring. BL

**Days 5-8 Nile Cruiser**

**Day 9 Cairo**

After breakfast we disembark. Optional visit to Abu Simbel (page 20). Afternoon flight to Cairo. Transfer to hotel. B

**Day 10 Amman**

Transfer to Cairo airport for your flight to Amman. You will be met on arrival and transferred to your hotel. Amman is one of the oldest continually inhabited cities in the world where ancient ruins and mosques sit beside modern hotels and restaurants. B

**Day 11 Amman**

Morning guided city tour including the fascinating Roman Theatre and Nymphaeum and the enchanting Citadel. Afternoon excursion to Jerash. Explore its colonnaded streets, plazas, temples, theatres, baths and the famous Arch of Hadrian in the ruins of this well preserved city. B

**Days 12/13 Petra**

After breakfast depart via the King's Highway to Petra. On the way visit Madaba, home to the famous 6th century Mosaic Map of Jerusalem and the Holy Land. Continue to Mt Nebo, the mountaintop memorial of Moses. Final stop is Kerak to view a crusader fort before your arrival in Petra. On day 13 enjoy a full day private tour of Petra. Walk through the narrow rock canyon to visit the famous Treasury carved into a sheer rock face more than 2000 years ago. B

**Day 14 Wadi Rum/Dead Sea**

Drive to the desert landscape of Wadi Rum, home of Bedouin tribes with its maze of monolithic rock scapes rising up from the desert floor. Continue on to the Dead Sea for two nights. B

**Day 15 Dead Sea**

Today is at leisure to swim in the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth. Indulge in one of the many spa treatments or just explore the shores of this unique salt lake 422m below sea level. B
