



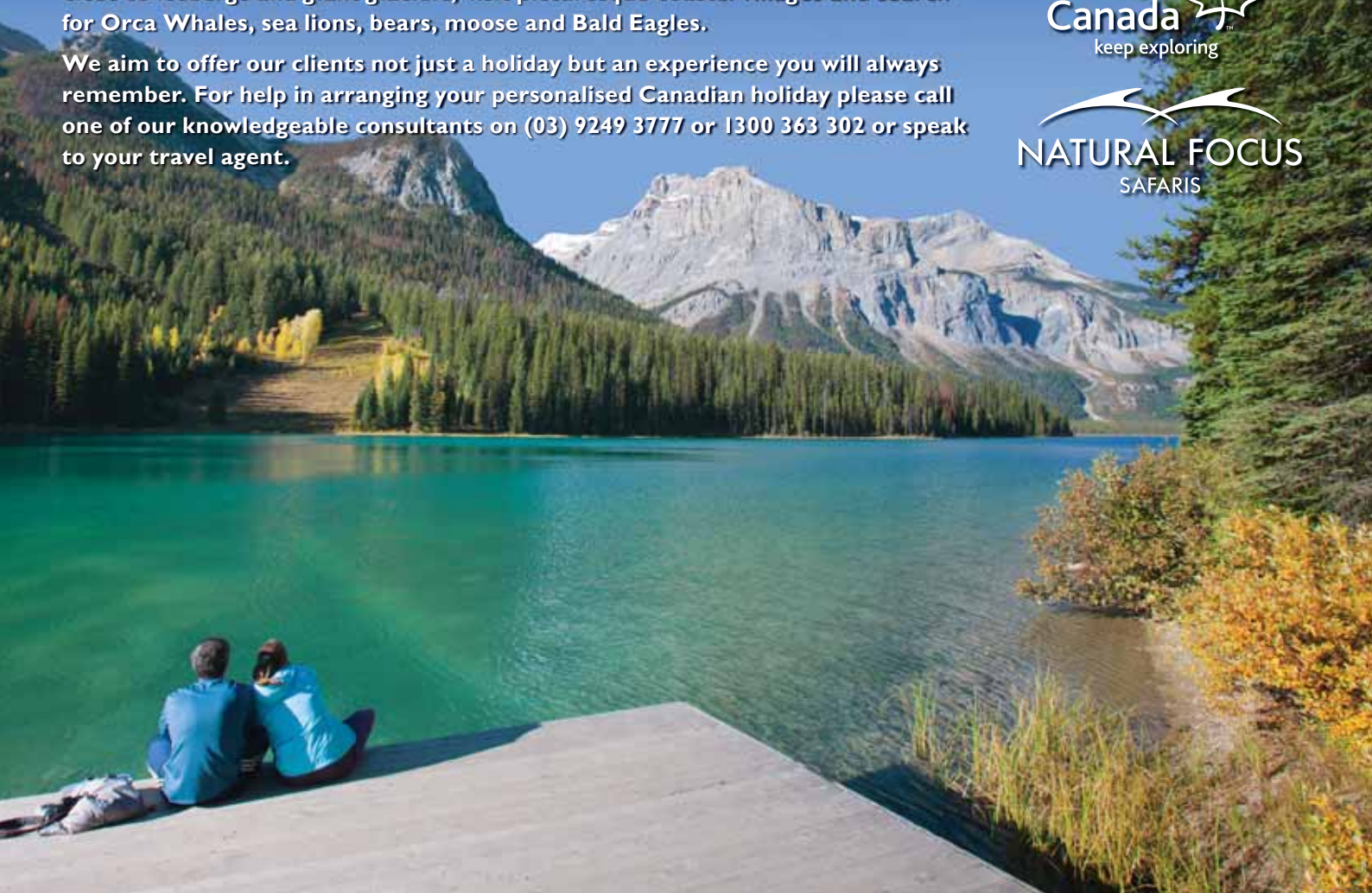

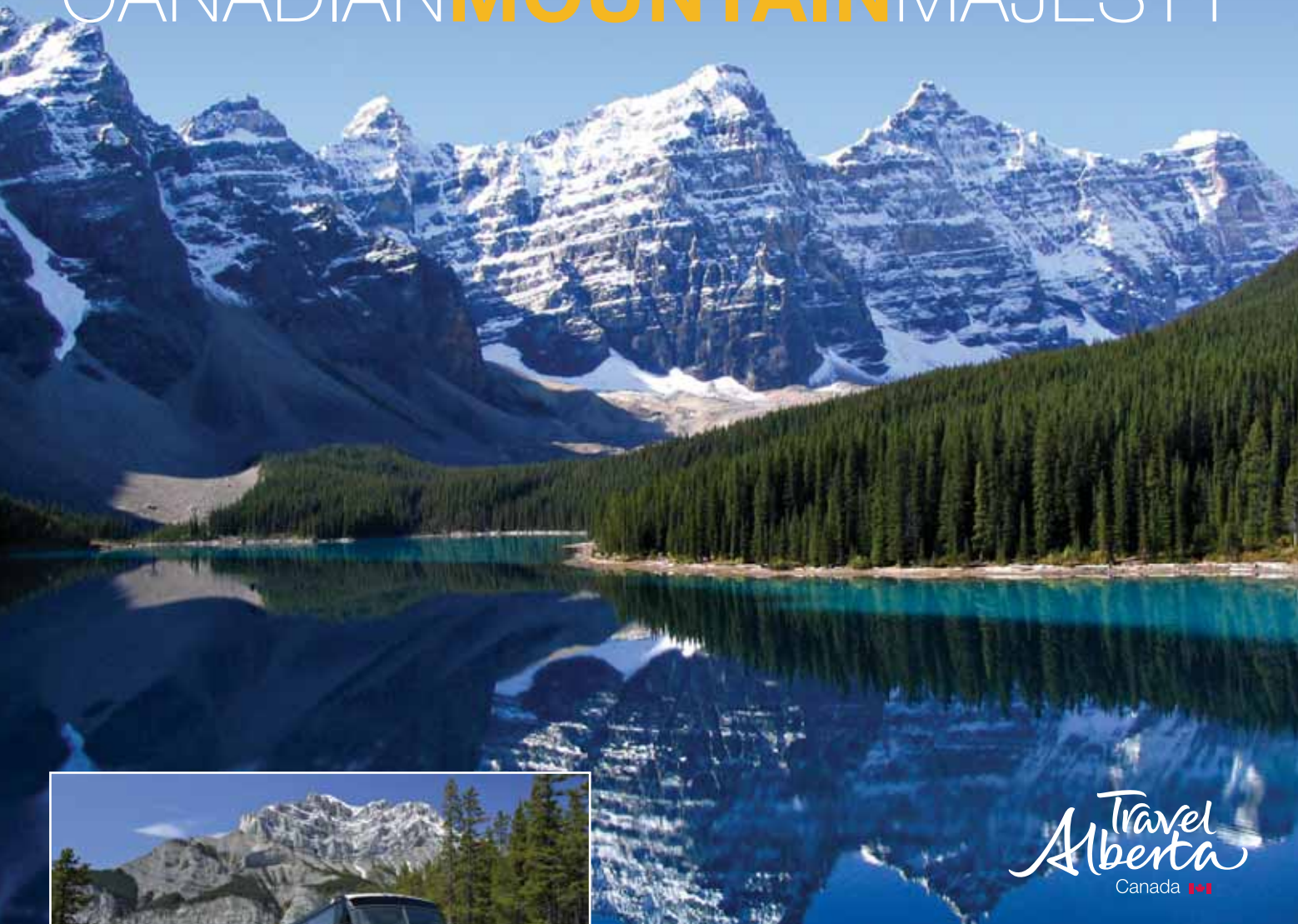

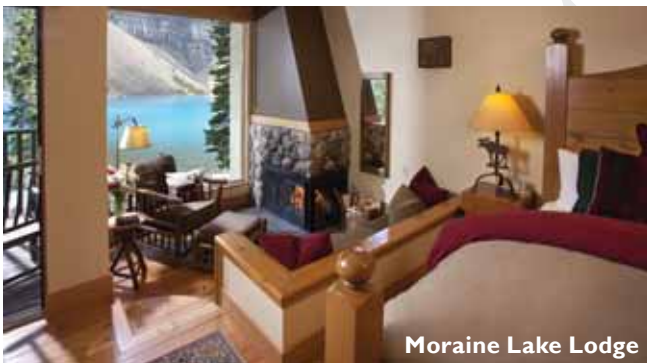

# IN SEARCH OF THE SPIRIT BEAR



Be one of the privileged few to visit secluded Spirit Bear Lodge on ancient tribal lands within British Columbia's Great Bear Rainforest. This is a unique eco-cultural wildlife-viewing experience which offers the chance to see amazing wildlife as well as a glimpse of ancestral cultural sites. Travelling by boat and on foot you will search for Grizzly Bears, Black Bears, wolves, deer and the rare and mysterious Spirit or Kermode Bear. Return at the end of the day to the modern and comfortable waterfront lodge built in the style of a traditional long house. From the huge glass windows you may see passing orcas, dolphins and sea lions. Your hosts and expert guides are the traditional Kitsoo and Xaixais people, the only permanent residents of this pristine wilderness.

We recommend a minimum stay of 5 days, costing \$3898 per person twin share for travel between 29 Aug-10 Oct. This includes one night hotel accommodation at Port Hardy on Vancouver Island, return float plane transfers to Spirit Bear Lodge, 3 nights full board accommodation in ensuite rooms and daily guided activities.
